ADORATION



Did you know that daily Adoration before the Blessed Sacrament was very important to Mother Teresa? She and her Sisters of Charity would spend at least an hour every day in Adoration. When the Sisters were sent to help flood victims in Bangladesh, they asked Mother Teresa to make an exception to this time of daily prayer so that they could spend more time working. Mother Teresa said NO. **She made it clear that the strength for their work came from receiving the Eucharist at Mass and spending time in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament.**

We need strength from the Lord for our work too!--in all the day to day aspects of our lives. Stop by the church on First Friday (July 7th) and spend time with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. Mass is at 8:30 AM. 24 hour Adoration begins at 9:00 AM. Sit quietly and pray, read the Bible or another spiritual book, or listen to Christian music on your phone (*good headphones required!*) You can come for 5 minutes or stay for an hour or more. **Parents, why not bring your children for a visit and help them learn the value of making time for prayer.**
