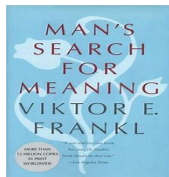

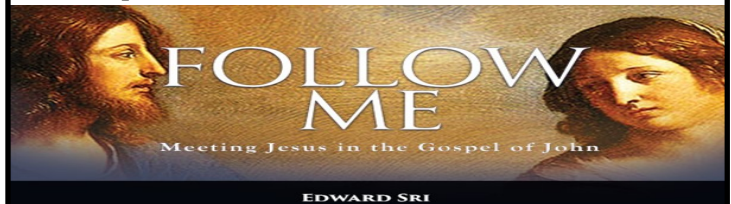
Classes are held after breakfast at 11:15AM to 12:30PM.
