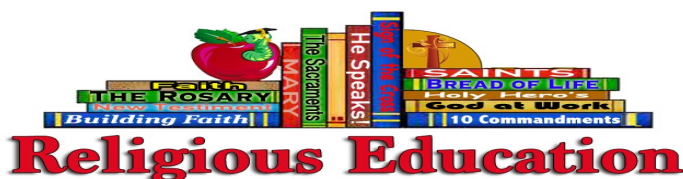
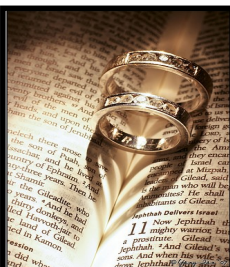

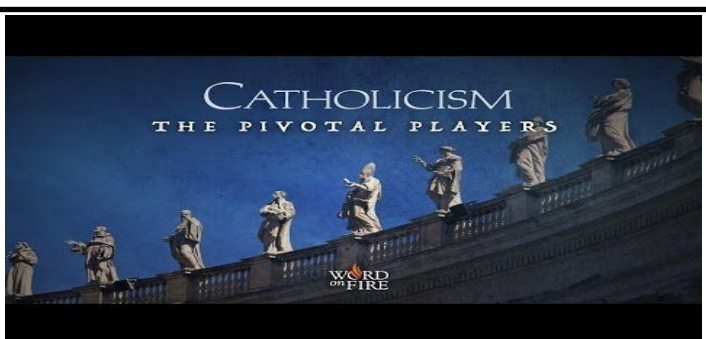
The book club is for adults only, and the book does contain some swear words. If reading profanity would offend you, then I recommend that you not participate in this discussion group.
