Part One: "Belonging," a discussion of Brene Brown's book *Braving The Wilderness: The Quest For True Belonging And The Courage To Stand Alone*

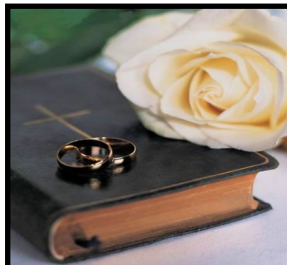
Buy the book now, and start reading!

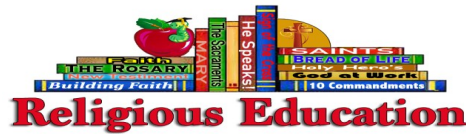
The book club is for adults only, and the book does contain some swear words. If reading profanity would offend you, then I recommend that you not participate in this discussion group.

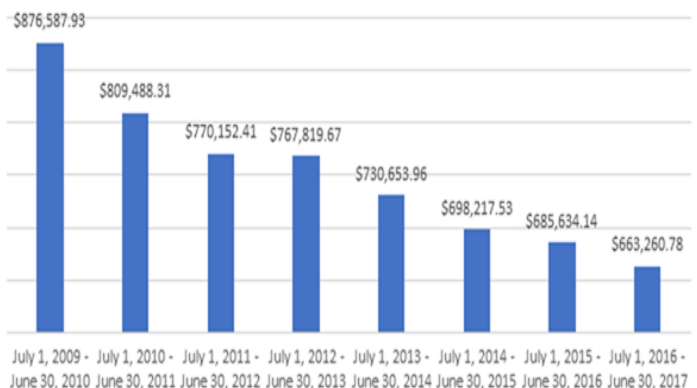
