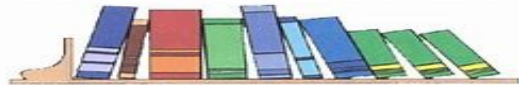

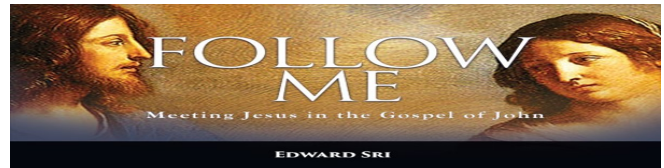
Faith Formation
